KENDALS RESTAURANT AT THE CLUBHOUSE

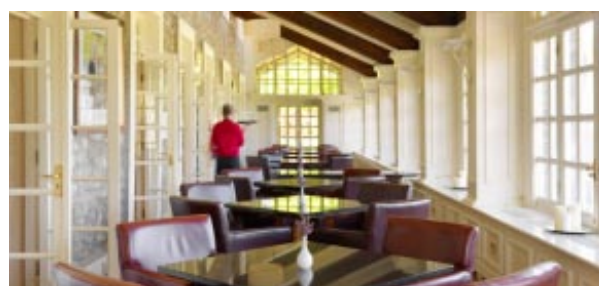


The 1 AA Rosette awarded Kendals Restaurant at the Clubhouse offers French Brasserie style cuisine in an informal setting.

CLAY PIGEON SHOOTING AND ARCHERY

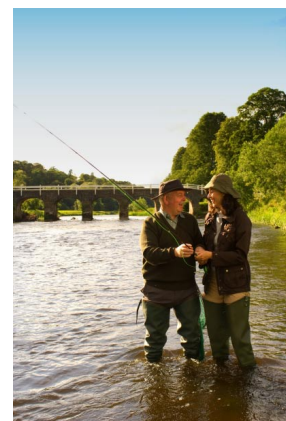

Nearby we have many picturesque villages and towns such as Thomastown, Inistioge, and Graiguenamanagh.

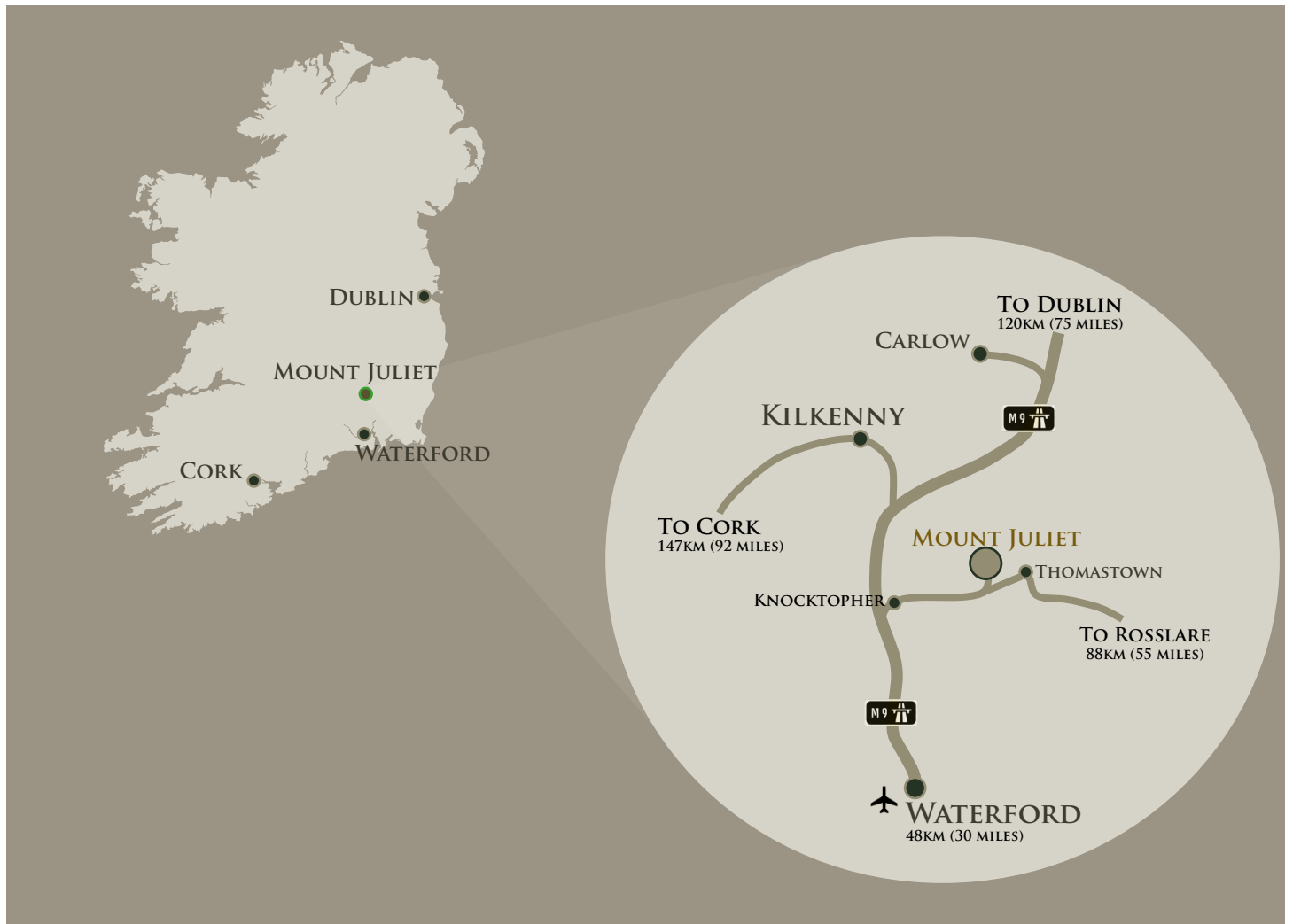
