CONDITIONS OF

MEMBERSHIP

- 1. The membership fee must be received in full before use of the Centre commences. In the event of default of the membership fee, entrance to the Centre and the use of the Centre's facilities will be denied.
- On your application being accepted you are committed to membership for a period of not less than six months.
 Thereafter 30 days notice in writing must be given to the Centre of your intention to cancel your membership.
 Membership fees are due up to the date of such cancellation. In the event that membership is not renewed within one month of expiry, it is deemed to have expired.
- 3. Mount Juliet Estate reserves the right to change membership fees. Members will be notified in advance of any such increases.
- 4. Membership deposits and membership fees are not refundable under any circumstances and temporary suspension of membership is not permitted.
- 5. Health Appraisal Forms (from Centre reception) must be completed and signed prior to using the health club facilities.
- 6. Guests must be accompanied by a member at all times, however Mount Juliet Estate reserves the right to refuse admission.
- 7. All members must register their name and membership number on entering the Centre.
- 8. Lockers are provided in the changing rooms for daily use by members and guests. Personal belongings may not be left overnight in the lockers. Unclaimed property is kept on the premises for a maximum of three weeks, after which it is donated to charity.
- 9. The member acknowledges that the club accepts no responsibility whatsoever for any personal injury, damage to or loss of personal property sustained by the member while he/she is using the club premises, facilities, or parking area.
- 10. Proper clothing/shoes must be worn at all times.
- 11. Children's pool hours are 9 am to 6 pm each day. It is the responsibility of the parents or guardians of children (under 16 years) to supervise them at all times while they are on the premises.
- 12. Children under 18 years are not permitted access to the steam room, the sauna or the exercise equipment.
- 13. Mount Juliet Estate reserves the right to utilise the Centre facilities for special events, private parties, seminars, tournaments or other activities and to thereby close the Centre with reasonable notice.
- 14. In the event of major reconstruction of the Centre premises, every effort will be made by Mount Juliet Estate to eliminate any diminution of Centre services. Membership will not be suspended and members' cooperation in this respect is assumed.

CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

- 15. Applicants who are unsuccessful will not be given any reasons for such refusal of membership.
- 16. Centre membership may be terminated by Mount Juliet Estate for violation of any rule or regulation of the Centre or for conduct deemed to be detrimental to the welfare, good order or character of the Centre and its members or for any other reason at the sole discretion of Mount Juliet.
- 17. Mount Juliet Estate reserves the right to amend and add to these Conditions of Membership. Members shall observe any amendments or additional conditions to the rules. On joining the Centre, members automatically accept and agree to be bound by the conditions of membership of the Centre.
- 18. The member acknowledges they have carefully read and understood the rules and regulations of the club and hereby undertakes to abide them.
- 19. On acceptance of an application for membership, the member will be issued with a membership card for entry to the club, this must be used at all times, with no exceptions.
- 20. The club reserves the right to restrict the number of persons using the club at any one time.
- 21. All new members must have a 15 minute induction to be shown proper use of the pool and gym facilities.
- 22. Footwear must be worn at all times on the gym floor, flip flops or bare feet are not allowed, flip flops may only be worn in the pool or spa areas.
- 23. If your health changes during your membership you must let us know.
- 24. If you feel dizzy, faint, or unwell you must stop exercising and inform a member of staff immediately.
- 25. Shaving is not permitted in steam room, sauna areas or changing rooms.
- 26. In the event of an emergency members must agree to follow the directions of the manager/supervisor in charge of the situation.
- 27. All accidents must be reported to a member of staff and documented.
- 28. Poolside rules must be adhered to at all times.
- 29. Glass bottles or containers are not permitted on the premises.
- 30. Children under the age of 3 must wear a swim nappy, these are available for purchase at reception.
- 31. All members/guests must wear swim caps, these are available at reception.
- 32. It is your responsibility to report any change of circumstance to your health to a member of the club team.

HEALTH CLUB RULES

- Members must register with their Membership Card at Health Club Reception.
- Children's Hours 9.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Sunday. This applies to all guests up to 18 years of age.
- For safety reasons, all children up to the age of 16 years must always be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- · Guests under the age of 18 years may not use the steam room, sauna or exercise equipment.
- Swimming caps must be worn.
- · Management are not responsible for loss or damage to property. Please use lockers provided.
- · Food is not to be consumed at the pool side. No glass is allowed in changing areas or pool deck.
- · No diving, running, ducking or shouting.
- Health appraisal forms must be completed and signed prior to using the exercise machines. These are available at the Health Club Reception.
- In the interest of hygiene, please shower before entering the pool.
- The Health Club opening hours are Monday to Friday from 7.00am to 9.00pm and Saturday and Sunday from 8.00am to 9.00pm
- Phone / Cameras are strictly not permitted in the changing rooms, gym and swimming pool areas.
- · No outdoor shoes on the pool deck.
- Please wear flip-flops or non-slip shoes in all wet areas.
